MISSION

The mission of The Women's College Club of Princeton is:

- To raise money for college scholarships for women from Princeton public and private secondary schools who need financial assistance to meet the high costs of tuition.
- To provide cultural enrichment for our members by offering speakers, interest groups, and trips.
- To encourage fellowship among members.

Over the years the WCCP has given over \$800,000 in scholarships.

HISTORY



In 1916, the year that the WCCP was founded, there were ninety-seven women in Princeton who held college degrees. About two-thirds of them became charter members of the club.

Seeing the need for local young women to have access to higher education, the club awarded interest-free loans for the purpose. Scholarships were added in 1928. The total for scholarships that year was \$250. In 2016, the club's 100th Anniversary, scholarships totaled \$28,500. Since 1928, the club has given recipients awards of \$700,000.

In 1966, its fiftieth anniversary year, WCCP numbered over 400 members and represented more than 100 colleges and universities world-wide. Today, with many women pursuing careers, the club has a smaller membership, but it continues in its mission to help deserving and outstanding college-bound young women to meet their expenses.
