

Joyce Felsenfeld will give an art talk focusing on an early 20<sup>th</sup> century artist, Amedeo Modigliani. Born in Livorno, Italy, he moved to Paris and became a painter and sculptor of the École de Paris, mainly working in France. He was flamboyant and lived an often wild, bohemian lifestyle, all while making many beautiful portraits of the many people he knew. He had an avant-garde style, and his faces are unique with characteristic elongated, melancholic features and emotion. Though his life was cut short by illness, dying in poverty and obscurity, he is now celebrated as one of the 20th century's most significant, highly valued modern artists.

Joyce studied with a Princeton University professor to be a museum docent upon retiring as a faculty member at Stuart Country Day School. She is a NJ native, a graduate of Douglass College and did graduate work at Rutgers.
